School Response to Coronavirus Update

16th March 2020

Dear Parents/Carers

The biggest responsibility we have as a school is keeping the children, staff and wider community safe. The situation the world currently faces is unprecedented in modern times, and so I am writing to you today to explain the steps we are taking as a school to keep our community as safe as possible in these challenging times.

From today, Monday 16th of March, the school has taken the following steps:

- Parents Evening for Year 8 (25th March and 1st April) and Year 7 (22nd April and 29th April) are postponed. We will contact parents about pupil progress in the summer term.
- The Year 4 brass performance (2nd April) and the Year 3 wartime museum event (30th March) are also postponed.
- All sporting fixtures are postponed. Internal school clubs will carry on until further notice, including Primary wrap around care at Oakgrove Primary School.
- There will be no external visitors to the school. The school will contact people to rearrange any previously organised meetings.
- All trips and visits until May half term are cancelled. We will be in touch with parents as soon as possible with further information.
- Staff will not attend any external meetings, conferences and courses.
- There will be no assemblies.
- Primary and secondary pupils will not move between the two sites.
- We will stagger lunch and break times and use separate venues so that the whole school is not in the Dining Hall together.

We will continue to keep parents updated with any information we receive, but we also rely on your vigilance and support in keeping our communities safe. Please check the government website for the latest updates. Please do not contact the school for medical advice as we are unable to give any.
