There are no cases of Coronavirus at Kents Hill Park School, but it is important that we make preparations should it be necessary to close the school for a period of time. This would be part of the Government's response to delay the spread of the virus.

As far as possible, and in order to prepare for such an event, the school has taken steps to reduce the disruption to learning. Staff have placed work for each subject area on our VLE. We have ensured that all pupils have access to this, but please check that you can access information at home. If you are unable to, please ask your son/daughter to speak to their form tutor as soon as possible. Should we close, this work will become available.

Again, please ensure that they can be accessed and let us know if there are any issues.

At the Primary, a booklet has been produced that will be handed to pupils as long as we have enough notice of closure. If not, it will be emailed to parents.

If any pupils do not have access to the internet at home, it is important that you let your child's form tutor know as soon as possible so that we can make provision for their learning. Planned trips, visits and fixtures will continue as scheduled unless we are instructed to close.

I will continue to keep you updated with current Government advice over the coming weeks as we know more. However, it is important that you continue to encourage your children to follow the advice around regular hand washing with soap and water, using and binning tissues, and trying to avoid touching their face.

This is a challenging situation for all of us, but I am sure that we will be able to work together to ensure that we support each and every member of our school and wider community.
