



## Marvellous Maps



We will begin the half term developing our Geography fieldwork skills through our Marvellous Maps topic. We will explore what maps are, how they help us and how keys are used. We will then further develop our knowledge to create and follow sketch maps and, by looking at maps of different scales, will investigate land use in Great Britain. There will be lots of opportunities for us to practise the use of mathematical vocabulary to describe position, direction and movement, as well as developing our skills to write sets of instructions.
