APPLICATION FOR KENTS HILL PARK SCHOOL NURSERY SEPTEMBER 2026

Thank you for your interest in Kents Hill Park School Nursery. This application form is for children born between 1st September 2022 and 31st August 2023. To apply for a place at Kents Hill Park School Nursery starting in September 2026 the attached form should be completed and returned to the school by email to admissions@KET.education

Please note that the form is an editable PDF and should be saved to the device you are using, then completed and then press SAVE before attaching to an email. Please ensure that you attach all the supporting documentation to that email.

Parents have the option of applying for the following sessions at Kents Hill Park Nursery:

- 15 hours a week morning session - 5 morning sessions from 8.30am – 11.30am
- 15 hours a week afternoon session - 5 afternoon sessions from 12.30pm-3.30pm
- 30 hours a week all day sessions - 5 daily sessions from 8.30am-2.30pm

Parents of children attending an all-day session can extend their child's session by an hour. The extra hour of childcare can be purchased. The extended day session will run from 8.30am -3.30pm.

Please be aware that a place in the nursery **does not** give automatic admission to the primary school.

Please note that in order for your application to be considered, all relevant sections of the form must be completed and the appropriate documentation attached / enclosed. Kents Hill Park School Nursery requires confirmation of your child's date of birth, and also requires proof that you and your child are living at the address stated on the application form. You are therefore asked to attach a photo / scan of the following documentation to your completed application form.

- A current council tax statement or recent utility bill to confirm your address
- A recent official document which confirms your child's date of birth (passport / birth certificate)
- Also, that he/she lives at the address stated (examples of this can be letter from hospital / GP/ health team / benefit statement/ savings statement)

The deadline for submitting the application form is 12 noon on Friday, 13th March 2026. Allocations for nursery will be made with applicants receiving notification by email / post by Friday, 27th March 2026. If the Nursery is unable to offer a place to your child, you will be informed in writing. There is no right of appeal. However, the Nursery will hold a continued interest list and you may request that your details are included.

NURSERY ADMISSION ARRANGEMENTS FOR SEPTEMBER 2026

Defined area:

Defined area for Kents Hill Park Primary and Nursery is Browns Wood, Caldecotte, Walnut Tree, Walton, Walton Park, Kents Hill and Kents Hill Park

Oversubscription criteria:

If the School is oversubscribed, after the admission of pupils with a Statement of Special Educational Need or an Education, Health and Care Plan where the School is named in the statement or plan, priority for admission will be given to those children who meet the criteria set out below, in order:

1. A 'Looked After Child' or a 'Previously Looked After Child' as defined in the [Admissions Arrangements for Primary in September 2026](#).
2. Children who live in Kents Hill Park Primary School defined area and will have a sibling attending Kents Hill Park School* at the time of application with a reasonable expectation that the sibling will be attending at the start of the new academic year of proposed admission.
3. (a) Children of staff who have been employed at Kents Hill Park School* for two or more years at the time at which the application for admission to the school is made, and/or
(b) Children of staff who are recruited to fill a vacant post at Kents Hill Park School* for which there is a demonstrable skill shortage. It is at the absolute discretion of the Chair of the Local Governing Body to determine when there is a demonstrable skill shortage.
4. Children who live in Kents Hill Park Primary School defined area.
5. Children who live outside Kents Hill Park Primary School defined area and will have a sibling attending Kents Hill Park School* at the time of application with a reasonable expectation that the sibling will be attending at the start of the new academic year of proposed admission.
6. All other children.

* Where reference is made to Kents Hill Park School, this refers to Kents Hill Park School including both primary and secondary school age children, i.e. from Year R to Year 11.

Oversubscription: Distance Tiebreaker

In the event of there being more applicants meeting any of the above criteria than remaining places available, distance between the applicant's residence and Kents Hill Park Primary School will be used as a tiebreaker, with those living nearest given priority. Distance from the School is measured from the main entrance of Kents Hill Park Primary School to the front door of the applicant's residence, in a straight line using a computerised measuring system. For applicants living in flats, the distance will be measured from Kents Hill Park Primary School's main entrance to the front door of the ground floor flat underneath the applicant's residence. Priority will be given to the lower flat door number if there is more than one applicant from a block of flats.

Continued Interest List

There is no right of appeal if it is not possible to offer a place in the nursery. However, the nursery will hold a continued interest list and you may request that your child's details are included.
